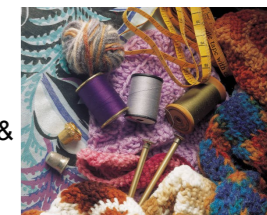

### Using the Database

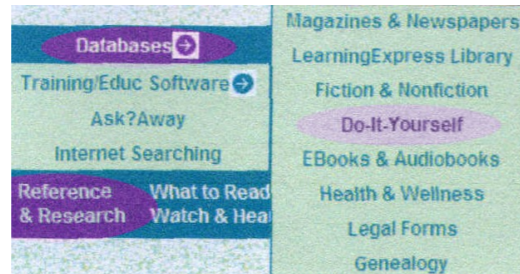

There is also a good video tutorial in the upper left corner of the “Help” page.

### Accessing the Database

You can access **Hobbies and Crafts** from our library web site at [www.antigopl.org](http://www.antigopl.org)

Near the top of the home page, you will see a horizontal bar with menu options. Move your mouse over **Reference & Research**, and a menu will appear. Move your mouse so that it highlights **Databases** on this menu, and a submenu



will drop down. Click on “Do-It-Yourself” to open a new page.

There are three databases on this page. Scroll down and click on the **Hobbies and Crafts** icon.

If you are using this database within the library, a single click takes you to the **Hobbies and Crafts** site.

*If you are accessing the database from outside the library, you will first be prompted for your 14-digit library card barcode.*
