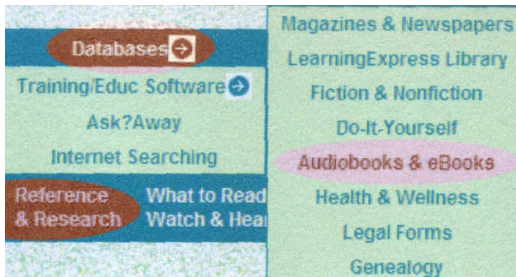


Accessing the Database

Access **OverDrive** from our library web site at www.antigopl.org

Near the top of the library home page, you will see a horizontal bar with menu options. Move your mouse over **Reference & Research**, and a menu will appear. Move your mouse so that it highlights **Databases** on this menu, and a submenu will drop down. Click on "Audiobooks & eBooks" to open a new page.



There are two databases on this page. Scroll down and click on the **OverDrive** icon.

Using the Database

At the **OverDrive** home page, you will find a **Help** link in the upper right corner. Click on this, and a page of several topics will appear. Select the most relevant one.

Features of OverDrive:

Overdrive is a digital library of fiction, nonfiction, music, videos and more, any of which can be downloaded and enjoyed on a computer or portable device. You can "check out" and download these materials anytime, anywhere!

Internet access is needed to browse, check out, and download titles. After download, you can enjoy a digital title without being connected to the Internet. You can then play the title on your computer with speakers or headphones, burn audio titles to CD with the Burn to CD Wizard, or transfer the titles to a compatible device using the built-in Transfer Wizard.

You can check out and download the following types of digital materials at this website...

- OverDrive WMA Audiobooks
- OverDrive MP3 Audiobooks
- OverDrive Music
- OverDrive Video

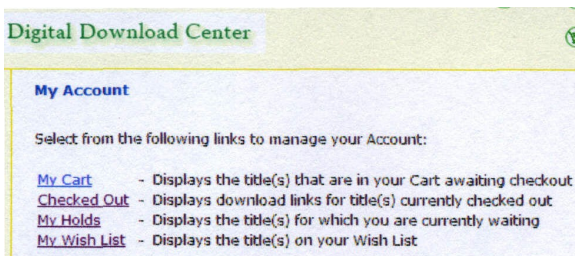


To access these digital materials you need...

- A valid library card
- Internet access
- A computer or device that meets the system requirements for the type(s) of digital materials you wish to check out
- Free software for the computer or device on which you wish to use the materials available at this site

Create an Account

When you first go to the OverDrive site from the library's web site (www.antigopl.org), click on the "Sign In" in the far upper right corner. You will then be prompted for your Library System: Select *Wisconsin Valley Library Service* from the menu. Then enter your complete 14-digit library barcode number.



What is My Account?

The 'My Account' section is a collection of links you can use to access your account information. When you attempt to access this section of the site, you will be prompted to enter your library card number into a secure sign in form. We require your library card number to ensure the security of your account.

What is the 'Checked Out' section?

The 'Checked Out' section lists all of the materials you currently have checked out. You can re-download materials from the 'Checked Out' page.

What is the 'My Holds' section?

The 'My Holds' section lists all titles that you have currently placed on hold. You'll receive an email notification once a title you have placed on hold becomes available. Note that if a title has become available since you placed the hold, an 'Add to My Cart' link will be displayed next to the available title. Use this link to add the title to your Cart and check out.

What is the 'My Wish List' section?

You can use the 'My Wish List' section to save a list of titles that you are interested in checking out, including titles that have not yet been released.

Search and Download

Browse or search this site for downloadable materials. When you locate a title of interest, add it to the Cart and check out the title. Once you have checked out a title, a download page is displayed. Click the 'Download' link to start the download. Once the download is complete, open and enjoy the title. You will never accrue late fees with titles you download from this website. At the end of the loan period, titles will expire and be automatically 'returned' to the library. At this time, you can delete the expired file(s) from your computer.

If a title is currently checked out, you can put a hold on it.
