**Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Kassis at 10:30 a.m.

Attendance: DeHart, Kassis and Scupien Also in attendance: Dominic Frandrup, and Maria Pregler, Assistant Director.

DeHart moved to approve the minutes of Tuesday, July 27, 2021. Scupien seconded. Carried.

AVA art installation.

Frandrup stated AVA would like to guarantee there's space for artwork in the library's greenspace plan, and that it's up to the board to decide what types of art they would prefer. Kassis suggested having AVA paint a mural on the fence in the back of the building. Frandrup suggested also having AVA paint the benches the Rotary is going to provide. DeHart moved to approve AVA creating a mural, creating a piece for the outside wall, and a freestanding piece. All artwork can be approved by the Director. Scupien seconded. Carried.

Greenspace Plan.

Kassis suggested finding out where the library's lot line ends. Other committee suggestions included putting up a shelter with pavers that can be engraved and paid for by donations. Kassis suggested concrete instead of pavers as it is a safer option. Frandrup questioned if the committee would be interested in placing benches around the north lawn. Scupien suggested asking for funding from the Foundation. Dehart moved to approve Frandrup pursuing quotes for sidewalk, benches and a shelter. Scupien seconded. Carried.

Keyless Entry.

Frandrup stated he would like to consider offering after hours meeting room access by installing a keyless entry system. Doing so would not increase staffing needs. However, without the keyless entry, a case could be made for increased funding. Scupien moved to go forward with keyless entry project as it will offer a community space to the public with little impact to the city and county budgets. DeHart seconded. Carried.

Clermont St. handicapped entrance.

Frandrup stated he received two quotes for installation of a handicapped door on the Clermont side, and the quotes are \$200 different. The price difference is due to the brand of door opener. DeHart moved to approve going forward with the project. Scupien seconded. Carried.
