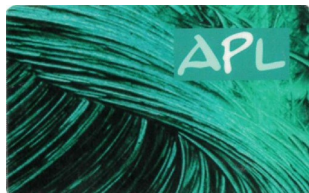


## Your Library Card

throughout the year.

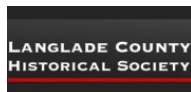


Individual services by request include

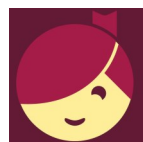
